## A scientific project in the Atacama Desert

The Atacama Desert is a plateau in South America, covering a 1000-km strip of land on the Pacific coast. It is the driest nonpolar desert in the world.

A group of scientists exploring the caves in the desert has recently stumbled upon water, animal bones and presumably some evidence of prehistoric human activity.

The mission of the expedition was to develop a technology which could help scientists to spot caves on Mars. Martian caves are thought to be suitable places to look for life. The scientists studied the thermal signatures of caves in hot arid places like the Atacama Desert here on Earth.

The average rainfall in the region is about 1 mm a year, which means that it is the second driest place on Earth (except the Antarctic).

Nobody had expected to discover water inside the cave, so it became a total surprise.

The team didn't see any footprints while they were going, so the cave (Cueva Chulacao) seemed to be untouched. There was only the slightest evidence of human presence. Halfway down the passage the scientists discovered damp mud, someone's foot even sunk into the soil. The moisture was obviously coming from the salt stream winding along the passage. There is no known source of water in the vicinity.

For many years scientists have been looking for water on Mars. Thus the finding in the Atacama Desert may become a clue in the future. The water has been discovered in the driest place below the Earth's surface.

Another important discovery took the team aback. In another cave they found animal remains: bones, skulls and other fragments mixed with tree branches. They gave the cave a new name — the Cave of the Bones.

The reason why all those animals had been trapped there before they died is still unclear. It might have been a flood. It is also possible that they were dumped into the cave by some prehistoric people.

Infrared scanners assist scientists in cave hunting on the surface of the red planet. They are installed on board a spacecraft orbiting Mars. So, Martian caves are more easily detected with the help of the techniques applied in the desert project. The caves are most likely to contain microorganisms that might still exist or have ever existed on Mars. Besides, caves may be used as future habitats for astronauts as they are able to protect the explorers from sun radiation and the harsh conditions of the red planet.

The scientists will continue working on the project and conduct the same experiments in the Mojave Desert in California.

	Hazelnuts harvesting		
Haze	elnuts are harvested annually in mid-autumn. As autumn comes to a close,

own, rather than **(B)** \_\_\_\_\_\_. The harvesting of hazelnuts is performed either by hand or by manual or mechanical raking of fallen nuts.

Four primary pieces of equipment are used in commercial harvesting: the sweeper, the harvester, the nut cart, and the forklift. The sweeper moves the

nuts into the center of the rows, the harvester lifts and separates the nuts from

twigs and leaves, the nut cart holds the nuts picked up by the harvester, and the forklift **(C)** \_\_\_\_\_\_.

The sweeper is a machine that makes two passes in each tree row. It has a 2 m belt attached to the front that rotates to sweep leaves, nuts, and small twigs from left to right, **(D)** . On the rear of the sweeper there is a powerful blower to blow the material left into the next row with air speeds up to 90 m/s.

The sweeper prepares a single center row of nuts narrow enough for the harvesting tractor to drive over without driving on the center row. Hazelnut orchards may be harvested up to three times during the harvest season. It (E) \_\_\_\_\_ and the rate of nut drop as a result of weather. The harvester is a slow-moving machine pushed by a tractor, which lifts the material off the ground and separates the nuts from the leaves, empty husks, and twigs.
