Fly Guy was curious.




“Snakes aren’t as scary as people think,”
said Buzz. “Let’s find out more!”


They opened the door and stepped inside . . .



Snakes are reptiles. Lizards, turtles, and crocodiles are reptiles, too.




All reptiles have scaly skin, lungs for breathing, and backbones.
